

Tyres are expensive - look after them

There are 3 main indicators that you might have a wheel alignment issue:

- 1) Uneven tyre wear
- 2) Vehicle pulling to the left or right at open road speeds
- 3) Your steering wheel is crooked

When we do a wheel alignment we are checking steering, suspension and vehiclular geometry. First we check steering/ suspension components and tyre pressures. These all have to be within spec before we go any further. We also check tyre condition and look for abnormal wear patterns. We then road test the vehicle to get a feel of how the wheel alignment/vehicle is behaving on the road. Once we have a general overview of the vehicle, we put it on our special wheel aligning hoist and connect our four wheelwheel alignment equipment to each wheel. We select the correct vehicle make and model from our extensive wheel alignment database and carry out a full four wheel geometry check. Once we have established what the actual vehicle wheel alignment settings are, we carry out adjustments to each wheel if possible to correct any abnormalities. This is the point where our experience comes in to play as we often have to set up the left hand side of the vehicle slightly different to the right hand side to counteract the camber pull that is prevalent on a lot of New Zealand roads. This is where the shape of the road tends to make the car want to drift to the left. When we are happy with our settings we remove the wheel alignment equipment and road test the vehicle. This confirms our settings are correct and we make sure the steering is straight. If not, we make slight corrective adjustments. Some vehicles' specifications don't work for New Zealand conditions so we do a custom set up. This ensures optimum life from your tyres. Unfortunately there are vehicle types in New Zealand that are very hard on tyres and it is not possible to eliminate premature tyre wear but we do minimise it. For example VW Passats, early Commodores, lowered vehicles and commercial vans. With our in-house vehicle wheel alignment knowledge we have been able to improve tyre life on these vehicles.

We recommend a wheel alignment every 10-15,000 kms or every 12 months (much easier to remember). This ensures optimum vehicle handling and extended tyre life. When we do a wheel alignment, it is loaded into our database system and you will get a follow up call 12 months later. We put a reminder sticker on your windscreen, up by your WOF sticker. We record when your next wheel alignment is due and also what your tyre pressures should be set at. Different vehicles require different tyre pressures. We

recommend you check your tyre pressures and tyre condition monthly. If you have any concerns swing by and chat to us at the workshop. If in doubt get us to check it out!

Driving Tip

Car Care Tip- With more and more modern vehicles around being diesel powered, it is imperative that you use the correct oil when topping up your engine. A lot of new diesel vehicles have what is called a Diesel Particulate Filter (DPF) fitted in the exhaust system. Using the wrong oil can cause catastrophic irreversible DPF blockage and failure. DPFs can cost up to \$9000 to replace. We carry 8 different diesel oils which cover most of New Zealand's diesel fleet. If you are unsure please PLEASE seek professional advice. Don't take the "This should be right" option. Always use the correct option.

Safe Driving Tip

REMEMBER our 'Holiday Check' option these holidays. If you want us to check over your vehicle before you go on holiday we will check the fluids, battery status, tyre pressures and give it a quick once over- all for the small price of \$40. Knowing your car is safe before you go on holiday will be one less thing to worry about.
