Hands Off the WOF

The government is reviewing the vehicle licensing system with the proposed options focused on extending the time between WoFs (warrant of fitness) and CoFs (certificate of fitness).

This REALLY concerns the team at Pirongia Action Automotive. We feel very strongly that vehicle and people safety are very much at risk if the WoF period is done annually instead of 6 monthly. We have done an audit of the last 1000 WoF checks through our workshop. 612 of the 1000 vehicles that have come through have initially failed. This could be due to simple things such as worn windscreen wipers, blown light bulbs or blocked windscreen washer jets which can be easily fixed during the WoF check and the car then passes its WoF. However some of the 612 failed vehicles have had more serious issues such as worn wheel bearings, steering and suspension joints or worn tyres and brakes. If these things are left for a further 6 months, what could have been preventative maintenance could result in real injuries from unsafe vehicles on the road or more expensive repairs being needed as the preventative maintenance might have turned into remedial repairs requiring more parts to be fitted.

The New Zealand fleet of vehicles is different to other developed countries, in that the average age of our vehicles is 13 years. This is significantly older than the other countries that the government has been comparing our WoF system with. Older vehicles with higher kms generally have more wear and tear issues. Two of the countries the government has been comparing us are looking at reducing their safety inspection interval more in line with our current system-Interesting!

We feel that the fleet of vehicles that are serviced by our team are of a high standard, and most clients feel it is important to keep their cars safe on the road by coming in for regular WoFs. However with 61% of the vehicles failing, what happens in an area that doesn't have a high standard of vehicles? There are a lot of people that are unaware of or don't care about the effectiveness of regular servicing and maintenance and how closely this relates to car safety.

When your car comes into Pirongia Action Automotive for a WoF we are ensuring that your car is safe to be on the road as well as making sure that all the key safety components are functioning properly. At this time we are also identifying potential wear that may have to be addressed in the future. We have often found that a good number of cars are overdue for a service when they come in for a WoF. Clients are made aware of any overdue services at this time. We are recommending to keep the WoF period at 6 monthly intervals, for regular safety checks on our clients vehicles. We want to keep our clients safe! If the Government doesn't listen to the majority of people- who want the system to remain unchanged and retain regular safety checks then we will be offering a 6 monthly safety check to make sure that our clients and their families are kept safe.

Motoring Tip

Here's a way to save you some time this summer. Why wait up to an hour for an out-of-Pirongia Serviceman to jump start your car? If you are within 5kms of the workshop we can jump start your car for \$10...and be there usually within 10 minutes during business hours (8:00am-5.30pm Monday- Friday, excluding public holidays)
